

Final Exam Week

End-of-course examinations should be given during final examination week. This is important for a number of reasons, including the need to provide students with the number of class hours reflected in the course credits, i.e. a three credit course should include 42 clock hours/didactic. Our catalog, academic manuals, and other official documents indicate that the students receive the number of didactic hours indicated in the course credits; thus the end-of-course examination should be scheduled during exam week, which is on the academic calendar for just that reason.
