Cost of Attendance 2019-20**

The cost of attendance (COA) reflects an estimate for an MSN/MPH student starting Summer 2019 for the 2019-20 academic year. It includes both direct and indirect expenses. Direct expenses that will be charged to students include tuition and, if applicable, a Matriculation fee and Health Services fee. Indirect expenses, marked with an asterisk, are estimates and not charged directly by the University. Students are billed per credit for tuition at a rate of \$1,742 per credit. *The COA estimate below only entails the first year of the program.*
