



**Masters Entry into Nursing
(MEN) Cost of Attendance 2019-20
New Students**

The cost of attendance (COA) reflects an estimate for an MEN student starting in the 2019-20 academic year during Fall 2019 or Spring 2020. It includes both direct and indirect expenses. Direct expenses will be charged to students include tuition and, if applicable, a Matriculation fee and Health Services fee. Indirect expenses, marked with an asterisk, are estimates and not charged directly by the University. *The COA estimate below for the Fall 2019 entering students entails the first three semesters of a five semester program. For Spring 2020 entering students the costs entail the first two semesters of a five semester program.*
