



**Masters Entry into Nursing (MSN)
Cost of Attendance 2021-22
Continuing Students**

The cost of attendance (COA) reflects an estimate for an MSN Entry into Nursing student continuing in the 2021-22 academic year who entered during either Fall 2020 or Spring 2021. It includes both direct and indirect expenses. Direct expenses will be charged to students include tuition and, if applicable, a Matriculation fee and Health Services fee. Indirect expenses, marked with an asterisk, are estimates and not charged directly by the University. *The COA estimate below for the Fall 2020 continuing students entails the last two semesters of a five semester program. For Spring 2021 entering students the costs entail the last three semesters of a five semester program.*
