



**Doctor of Philosophy in
Nursing Cost of Attendance
2022-23 New Students**

The cost of attendance (COA) reflects an estimate for a new PhD student for the 2022-23 academic year. It includes both direct and indirect expenses. Direct expenses will be charged to students include tuition and, if applicable, a Matriculation fee and Health Services fee. Indirect expenses, marked with an asterisk, are estimates and not charged directly by the University. *The COA estimate below is for a new or continuing PhD student during 2022-23. Students enrolling during a summer term will be billed per credit.*
