Cost of Attendance 2020-21**

The Cost of Attendance (COA) reflects an estimate of new DNP (CRNA) student’s educational expenses for the 2020-21 academic year. It includes both direct and indirect expenses. Direct expenses that will be charged to students include tuition and, if applicable, a Matriculation fee. Indirect expenses, marked with an asterisk, are estimates and not charged directly by the University. DNP-CRNA students are billed per credit for tuition at \$2,156 per credit.
