



**Doctor of Philosophy in  
Nursing Cost of Attendance  
2020-21 New and Continuing  
Students**

The cost of attendance (COA) reflects an estimate for a new or continuing PhD student for the 2020-21 academic year. It includes both direct and indirect expenses. Direct expenses will be charged to students include tuition and, if applicable, a Matriculation fee and Health Services fee. Indirect expenses, marked with an asterisk, are estimates and not charged directly by the University. *The COA estimate below is for a new or continuing PhD student during 2020-21. Students enrolling during a summer term will be billed per credit.*

<sup>1</sup>Tuition amounts are based upon Full-time enrollment at 9 credits per term. Tuition is billed at \$2,357 per credit and is lower for students enrolling less than Full-time.

<sup>2</sup>All students must have health coverage. Purchase of the University's plan is optional and if selected will be billed directly to the student's account.

<sup>3</sup>The matriculation fee is only charged to first time students at JHU. Continuing students are not charged a Matriculation Fee.

<sup>4</sup>Loan fees are not an additional charge to students. They are an allotment to help cover origination fees charged by the Department of Education.
