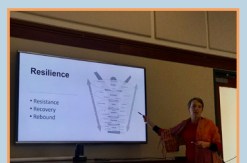
MISSION

The Center seeks to transform the diverse experiences of aging to enhance equity of well-being across the lifespan. We foster collaboration, mentorship and skill development that advances research, education, service, and knowledge translation to scale and sustain interventions.

The 2019 Center team members included the Center Director, Associate Director of Implementation Science, Associate Director of Interprofessional Education and Practice, Associate Scientist, Program Coordinator, Administrative Coordinator, Postdoctoral Fellow, Data Analyst, Social Design Associate, and 20 additional Principal Faculty.

2019 CENTER ACTIVITIES

- 24** **Dementia Working Group** and subgroup meetings, facilitating interprofessional collaborations on manuscripts, conference presentations, abstracts, and potential grants
- 10** **Intervention Working Group** sessions, bringing together faculty and students to problem-solve intervention challenges
- 7** **“Issue Is” seminars**, a forum for discussions around key issues related to intervention and implementation science
- 5** **Discrimination Journal Club and Working Group** sessions, spaces for critical discussion on how unfair treatment impacts health
- 4** **Joint Journal Club** meetings which discuss scientific literature that promotes positive outcomes for persons with chronic conditions
- 3** **Principal Faculty Meetings** bringing together the Center faculty to discuss research, resources, and Center happenings
- 2** **Pilot funding** awarded to Dr. Binu Koirala and PhD student Sarah LaFave for research

2019 SPECIAL EVENTS

Summer Research Institute (SRI)

On June 7th, 12 SRI participants workshopped behavioral intervention ideas while learning about delivery, fidelity, control groups, and recruitment. SRI generated \$16,000 in Center revenue.

Resilience Day

50 participants from across Johns Hopkins joined together for a day of learning titled “Advancing the Science of Resilience: What can we learn from other resilient systems?” Speakers included Dr. Ravi Varadhan, Dr. Jeremy Walson, Dr. Michelle Carlson, and Dr. Darrell Gaskin.

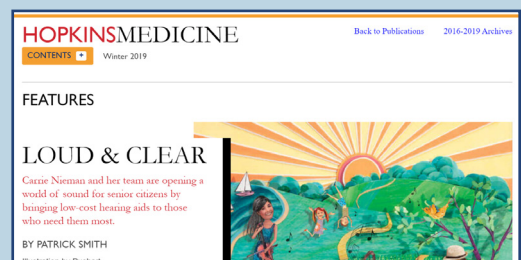
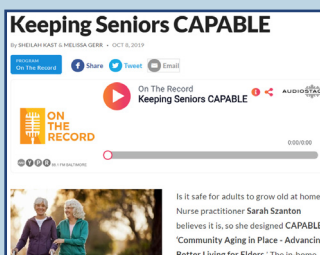
