


How do I access the course roster?

To view a list of students in your course, open the course site and click on Grade Center inside the Control Panel and select 'Full Grade Center.'

In the Full Grade Center, click the 'Work Offline' button in the top right corner, and select 'Download.'

Under the 'Data' heading, select "User Information Only"






Then click Submit – when the page refreshes, click the Download button to save the file to your computer. The file will contain any user information that is visible in the Grade Center (usually Last Name, First Name, Username (JHED ID), Student ID, and Last Access.

I do not want students to be able to see their grades on one particular assignment until I am finished grading all of them. How can I hide/unhide the column?


You can tell a column is currently hidden from student view if it has the symbol at the top of the column. To hide/unhide it from student view, click "Hide from Students (on/off)" from the drop down menu.


How do I change the due date of an assignment within the Grade Center?

Locate the assignment grade column and select 'Change Due Date' from its dropdown menu. Update the due date and time and click 'Submit' to proceed.



How do I give an additional attempt on an assignment?


In the Grade Center, access a cell's menu and select *View Grade Details*. The Grade Details page appears. *Allow Additional Attempt* only appears if a student has already submitted the maximum number of attempts allowed for that assignment. You can continue to offer opportunities to resubmit attempts each time a student reaches the maximum number.



How do I reset an exam attempt?


In the Grade Center, access a cell's menu and select *View Grade Details*. The Grade Details page appears. Select *Ignore Attempt* on the Grade Details page.

Note: Do not DELETE attempts. Please only IGNORE attempts, so that the data can remain in the classroom if there are any questions or concerns.



What do the icons in the Grade Center represent?


In the lower-right corner of the Grade Center, select *Icon Legend* to view the icon descriptions. Icons can appear in the Grade Center cells, attempt menus, column headers, on the *Grade Details* page, and on the *Needs Grading* page.



How do I give all students credit for a single question on an exam?

You may find an error on an exam question and need to give students full credit. You can easily do this within the Grade Center by selecting 'Grade Questions' from the exam dropdown menu. A list of exam questions will load. Locate the the question you would like to grade and then click the number in the 'Responses' column on the far right. The Grade Responses page will load, which shows all of your students' scores. Select 'Question Information' and select the 'Give Full Credit.' A pop-up will appear that states the following: This will give full credit to all submissions for this question and all subsequent submissions. This action is not permanent. You can remove full credit to revert scores. Click OK to continue.


What are SmartViews and how can I use them?

A smart view is a focused look at the Grade Center that shows only the columns that match a set of criteria. The view is saved for continued use. When the Grade Center includes a great number of students and columns, you can use smart views to quickly find data. Several smart views are available by default, but you can also create your own.

With smart views, you can view the progress of these items:

- An existing group
- Student performance for a particular item
- Individual students
- Category and status of items
- Custom combination of attributes

Is there a way to view only one student at the Grade Center at a time?

You can easily show a single student's row in the Grade Center by selecting the dropdown menu next to their name and selecting **Hide Other Rows**. You can then show all of the students' rows in the Grade Center by selecting **Show All Rows**.
