



Joining a Zoom Meeting

Zoom is a web conferencing service used at the JHU School of Nursing, and is best used for online meetings that need advanced sharing capabilities, including video collaboration, video recording, and screen sharing.

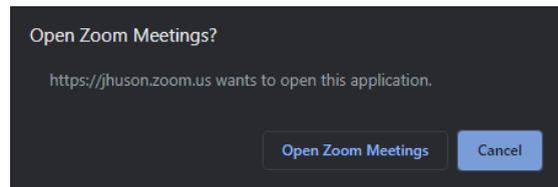
What You Need To Get Started

- An internet connected computer, laptop, or device
- Your meeting ID # and/or meeting link, e.g., <https://jhuson.zoom.us/j/61635446056>. (Here, the meeting ID is 616 354 460 56)
- A headset or ear buds
- A phone (if you're unable to receive audio via your computer)

How to Launch Zoom and Participate in Your Meeting

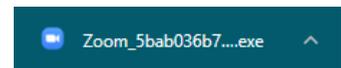
- **JOIN:** Click on the Zoom meeting link you were provided OR go to the SON Zoom page (<https://jhuson.zoom.us>) click the **Join** button, paste in the meeting ID and click **Join**.

- **OPEN ZOOM MEETINGS:** The next steps are the same for either option you chose above: A window will open in your computer's default web browser, and a small pop-up will appear that says "Open Zoom Meetings?" – select the Open Zoom Meetings button to launch the meeting in the meeting in the Zoom app.



- **DOWNLOAD & RUN ZOOM:** If you do not have the Zoom app on your computer, you will be prompted to download it. You may need to click on the **download & run Zoom** link. Once you click the link, a Zoom.exe file will download. You will need to double click on the exe file to launch the Zoom app. Your meeting will automatically launch as well.

Please click **Open Zoom Meetings** if you see the system dialog.



If nothing prompts from browser, [click here](#) to launch the meeting, or **download & run Zoom.**

- **AUDIO:** Once you've entered the meeting, a window will appear asking you to choose one of the audio conference options:
- **Phone call:** you call in, using the call-in info in the invite.
- **Computer audio:** You use your computer speaker and microphone for audio. (This is easiest.)
- **Call me:** You have Zoom call you (a good alternative when computer audio is not working).
