## Review Criteria:

We will review applications with a multi-disciplinary team of reviewers. Applications will be scored for potential benefit, feasibility and overall impact. Those wherein the patient is better understood, respected, treated with dignity, and shown compassion will be prioritized for funding.

- 6. 2<sup>nd</sup> challenge: What non-financial difficulties might you encounter? How will you address them?
- 7. Climax: Describe how this project, innovation or plan will help patients (and/or families). How many people will this project help?
- 8. Resolution: How will you know that your project worked? How will you evaluate if/how it made a difference?
- 9. If the project involves doing something new or different in a clinical setting, please include a letter confirming "approval" to move forward with idea if funded.
