



## STUDENT FAQ's:

1. What is DNP Scholars Day?
  - a. DNP Scholars Day is a celebration for DNP Graduates! We are celebrating the culmination of your DNP Project. We will recognize various students with project awards & class awards, along with showcasing a select few Project Posters. The program will end with a champagne toast & light bites, where you can mingle with your faculty, project advisors, colleagues & friends/family!
2. Is it required?
  - a. No, but it is strongly encouraged! We look forward to celebrating with you.
3. Do I need to present my DNP Project Poster?
  - a. If you are selected for a project award, we will invite you to present your poster during DNP Scholars Day. You will be notified well in advance! The presentation is brief; less than 5 minutes.
4. What should I bring?
  - a. Bring your regalia for Class Photos. We will store your regalia on your behalf until photos begin at 4:30 PM.
5. What do I do if I forgot my Sigma chord?
  - a. Sigma Cords are only provided to new inductees at JHSON who pay the membership and induction costs.
