Explore Career Options

Learn more about yourself and what you have to offer by exploring your interests, values, skills and life purpose. In this section, schedule an appointment to discuss undergraduate or graduate majors, academic concentrations/specializations, and industry preferences or career ideas. If you have completed one or more assessments such as the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI), CliftonStrengths, Strong Interest Inventory, CareerLeader, or others, review the results and consider how they influence career and life decisions.

Create Documents

In this section, you can schedule an appointment to discuss resumes, your curriculum vitae (CVs), cover letters and other correspondence (e.g. personal, research, or teaching statements, grant applications/other grant materials, and thank you notes). Learn how to create and polish your documents to align with your career interests and aspirations.

Find Jobs/Internships/Opportunities

In this section, you can schedule an appointment to learn how to launch your search, identify opportunities, and build your professional network. Prepare for your search. Research and create a target list of employers that align with your career interests and values. Build your professional network to ensure you have connections in your career field. Develop a job search action plan and learn about upcoming career fairs, employer information sessions, and other opportunities to meet alumni, recruiters and professionals in your field of interest.

Prepare to Interview


In this section, you can schedule an appointment to prepare for your interview: mock interview(s), case interview(s), behavioral interview(s), informational interview(s), and salary negotiation. The job search is a process that includes identifying your target industry and career function through research and exploration, developing well written and appropriate documents such as a resume or CV, and refining your professional brand. Interview success depends on your preparation. Research the organization and practice your interview strategy so that you make a great impression.

Develop Your Brand

In this section, you can schedule an appointment to identify the core skills and experiences that make up your personal brand and value proposition, elevator pitch, job talk, and social media presence (e.g. LinkedIn Profile). Learn why building your personal brand is important as you construct a vision of who you are and communicate your story to others. When others hear your name, what do they remember? What words come to mind when they see your face? How do they feel when they are with you?

Advance Your Career

In this section, you can schedule an appointment to discuss best practices for job and career transitions, negotiating promotions, and strategies/resources for personal, professional, and leadership development. Career and life transitions can be stressful. It's easy to feel overwhelmed. Remember that there are strategies you can use to help you manage these transitions effectively.



Be sure to book a Nursing appointment, not PDCO (meant for PhDs seeking non-academic career)

NFLP Requirements

Nurse Faculty Loan Program (NFLP)

► Loan cancellation of up to 85%

► Prepares and trains qualified nurse educators to fill faculty vacancies and increase the number of trained nurses entering the workforce

- Commitment of serving 4 years full-time as faculty at a U.S.-accredited school of nursing (SON) after degree conferral
 - Can be anywhere in the U.S., online or onsite, and even abroad but school has to produce U.S. RN graduates

Ways to Fulfill NFLP Service

Guidelines- see pg. 10

- 1) Full-time faculty at a SON (tenure or non-tenure track)
- 2) Part-time faculty (clinical instructor or adjunct) at a SON combined with:
 - Another part-time faculty position at a SON or
 - Part-time position as clinical preceptor/educator to RNs/RN students
- 3) Full-time advanced practice RN preceptor with joint faculty appointment while maintaining primary clinician role (academic-practice partnership framework)
 - Being an NP Mentor alone does not count

NFLP Service Requirements, Cont.

► Full-time is defined by the employer

► Employment while completing current degree <u>does not</u> count toward the service commitment, but we recommend getting such experience now to be a more competitive faculty candidate

► Employment must be obtained within 12 months of degree conferral and verified by the employer (you will get email from ECIS about an exit interview; <u>forms</u>)

NFLP Service Requirements, Cont.

- ▶ If completing a residency or fellowship, or fulfilling military obligation, must request deferment through Tricia Thompson with ECIS (pthompson@jhu.edu)
- ▶ If verified service is not upheld, the full loan must be repaid, with interest at prevailing market rate
- Can be hired by JHSON, but this is not guaranteed
- ► The Career Lab can assist with preparation, but it is <u>your</u> <u>responsibility</u> to find a position that meets requirements





Finding NFLP-Eligible Positions

Job Search Tips

- Prepare for the job search to take a few months / possible seasonality
- Apply to multiple positions
- ► Visit the Jobs/Careers websites of your target organizations, create a candidate profile, and sign up for job alerts (e.g., JHSON)
 - If org. does not have this feature, bookmark and regularly check the site
- ► Set up a <u>Google alert</u> on your top organizations and job title

Tip: If not getting a lot of results for a particular job title, try putting the title in quotes



Application Tips

- ► Follow the application directions exactly
- ► Have a current resume and CV; write a tailored cover letter

Secure references

Ask organizations how they define full-time (# of credit hours per semester or per academic year) and what their preceptor requirements are (# of hours per week, students, semesters)

Interview Tips

Academic

Typically scheduled for half to full-day

May be with Department/Program Chair, and/or other Department Heads, and/or other Faculty Members

Anticipate questions about previous courses you have taught or prior research you conducted

Expect to present on a teaching topic or aspect of your research; some of the questions may be situational in nature

Possible tour and/or meal

Clinical

Typically scheduled for several hours

May be with the manager or with a group including manager and peers

Anticipate questions about your expertise, initiatives you've created, and populations with whom you have worked

Expect to be asked to discuss responses to hypothetical situations
