






Research Question

Purposive sampling Colaizzi's method

Semi-structured, in-depth interviews and observations actively engaged with QR code technology, they regularly used it for recitation related to medical-surgical nursing


18 years and older, voluntarily agree to participate and share their experiences, including providing informed consent


