GACD eleventh joint funding call: Multisectoral Approaches to tackle NCD

The GACD is excited to announce the opening of our eleventh joint funding call. This call will focus on multisectoral approaches to tackling non-communicable diseases, supporting implementation research that works beyond the healthcare system to address chronic non-communicable diseases (NCDs) in underserved populations.

We welcome proposals in low- and middle-income countries ([LMICs](#)) and in populations experiencing inequity in high-income countries (HICs), including Indigenous Populations. Applications should explore implementation strategies that draw on collaboration across sectors and different settings where people learn, work and live, and may include cross-sectoral approaches involving both healthcare and non-healthcare sectors.

Parallel process: the European Commission opened a single-stage lump-sum funding call ([HORIZON-HLTH-2026-01-DISEASE-09](#)) on 10 February. The deadline for applications to this call is 16 April 2026 (17:00 Brussels time).

Joint process: Two international funding agencies have pre-announced participation in the joint-process GACD call so far – Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR) and National Health

and Medical Research Council (NHMRC), with more agencies expecting to join on a rolling basis. Discussions with South African Medical Research Council (SAMRC), Health Systems Research Institute (HSRI, Thailand) and Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) are ongoing. The deadline for Stage 1 applications will be 17 June 2026 (16:00 UTC).
